ACT Scholarship Program

Background:

Prior to this year, ACT awarded two scholarships per region:

- > **ACT For Excellence:** Academic award of \$750 to a student earning a Dean's List GPA.
- > **ACT Student Initiative Award:** \$250 contribution to a charity/organization of student's selection given to a student who identified a need on campus or in the community, and worked to provide a service or solution to address that need.

This year, 2011, ACT awarded one scholarship per region of \$1,000 to a student and \$250 for their chosen charity/organization to a student who demonstrated both a Dean's List GPA and campus/community service.

How should the scholarships be selected:

- > **By Region** – currently there are four regions:

Region I – University at Buffalo, The College at Brockport, Buffalo State College, SUNY Fredonia, SUNY Geneseo, Alfred State College

Region II – Binghamton University, SUNY Cortland, College at Oneonta, SUNY Oswego, SUNYIT, SUNY Delhi, Morrisville State College, Upstate Medical University

Region III – University at Albany, SUNY Plattsburgh, SUNY Potsdam, SUNY Canton, SUNY Cobleskill

Region IV – Maritime College, Stony Brook University, SUNY New Paltz, Old Westbury, Purchase College, Farmingdale State College, SUNY Downstate Medical Center, College of Optometry
