

Summary

The resolution contains four major recommendations:

1. Most first-year and second-year courses within the major will transfer and will fulfill requirements for the major.
2. A SUNY System Transfer website will be developed in order to provide general information and transfer advice to our transfer students.
The website will include:
 - A. Course-to-course equivalencies
 - B. Instructions for transfer
 - C. Link to formally approved articulation agreements
 - D. Link to campus transfer offices
 - E. Background information
3. A Transfer Review Committee will be formed which will resolve issues that prevent a course from transferring. The Committee will consist of four faculty selected from the University Faculty Senate and four faculty from the Faculty Council of Community Colleges. In addition, there will be one non-voting member from the Provost's Office and one student non-voting member.
4. SUNY System Administration should facilitate workshops and conferences within the disciplines throughout the State. The purpose of these discussions is for faculty to have regular conversations about their discipline courses and programs. These conversations will be used to inform the Transfer Review Committee.
