

Nicholas Barber

In June 1999, Nicholas Barber was appointed to the Schenectady County Community College Board of Trustees by the Governor of the State of New York for a term expiring June 2007, and has not only demonstrated a commitment and dedication to the College, the community, and the two year post-secondary education during his service on the SCCC Board, but he has continued to remain active even after the expiration of his term as trustee, and continued to serve as the Delegate to the New York Community College Trustees Association, playing a role in bringing its 2008 spring conference to Schenectady as a member of its Education Committee and introducing participants to our community; and, he has also presented programs on “Working with Local Sponsors” to SUNY community colleges trustees at past conferences of this organization. During his term on the Board, he served in the offices of Chairman and Secretary, as well as serving on the Education and Personnel Committee (Vice Chair), Community Relations and Student Affairs (Vice Chair), the College Planning Council, and the following advisory committees: Admissions, Job Placement, Paralegal and Workforce Development, and he has also advocated for community colleges locally, statewide and nationally.

Nicholas Barber has served on a number of boards of community organizations often in a leadership capacity. He is the host and producer of the Weekend Access Show MY TV, and the Schenectady Today Show (public access), where he has invited members of the Schenectady County Community College staff to appear to showcase the college and some of its efforts. He was an ambassador for community Colleges before his appointment to the SCCC Board of Trustees, during the term of his trusteeship, and after the expiration of his term.
