Howard N. Hellman graduated from SUNY Rockland Community College, Suffern, New York, (Associates Degree, 1972) and SUNY Oneonta (Bachelor of Science Degree). An entrepreneur at heart, in 1969, even before his graduation from Rockland Community College, he founded All Bright Electric, an electrical contracting firm serving the Hudson Valley region of New York and Northern New Jersey. In 1996, Howard went on to establish Hellman Management /Development LLC, which develops high-end residential subdivisions, affordable housing and mixed-use construction projects.

Howard was President and CEO of All Bright Electric until 2006 when he assumed the position as Chair of the Board of Directors.
