

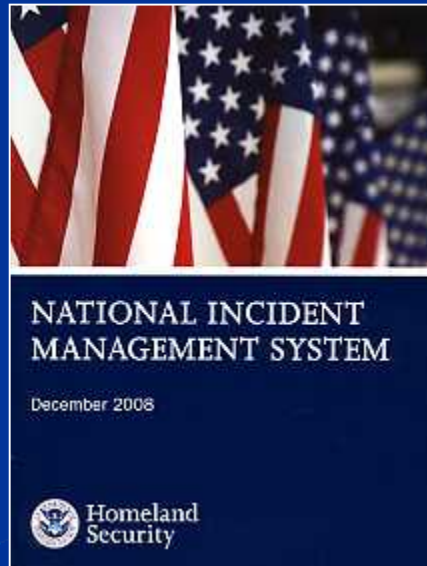

- Command & Management
  - Incident Command System
  - Multiagency Coordination System
  - Public Information
- Ongoing Management & Maintenance

# Incident Command System

- An Emergency Operations Center (EOC) staffed by an Incident Management Team (IMT)
  - EOC Manager (Incident Commander)
  - Public Information Officer
  - Operations
  - Planning
  - Logistics
  - Finance & Administration
