Subject: Control of Drugs on Campus

As reported in our memorandum of February 26, 1973 new Article 33 of the Public Health Law may require licensure of both institutional (Title III) and health care related (Title IV) use of controlled substances. Title III covers institutional use, including chemical research, instructional activities and chemical analysis concerning controlled substances. Such licenses should be reviewed by the Office of the Provost for Health Sciences for possible further submission to the State Health Department.

Title IV relates to the dispensation of controlled substances by physicians and other medical personnel. Each campus should communicate directly with the Bureau of Narcotic Control in the Health Department describing its clinic or health care operations involving controlled substances and requesting further guidance as to licensure requirements.
