The Attica Central School District encompasses an area in western New York State which includes the villages of Attica, Cowlesville, Strykersville, Darien Center, Varysburg and North Java.

The closest city is Batavia, located 12 miles to the north of Attica along Route 98. Buffalo and Rochester are the closest major cities, each located within an hour's drive from Attica. Major employers in the area are Attica Correctional Facility and Wyoming Correctional Facility. Agriculture is a major industry in the district.

Attica Central School is accredited by the New York State Board of Regents.

Attica High School is located on East Main Street (Route 238) at the eastern edge of the village of Attica, a village of approximately 2,600 people in Wyoming County.

Effective with the 9th graders entering in September 2005, Honors and college credit classes will be weighted for class rank. Honors courses are weighted 1.05 and advanced courses are weighted 1.08

The following Courses are honors courses: English 9, 10, 11 H; Global 9 & 10 H; Geometry R1; Biology R1; & Earth Science H

The following courses are advanced credit courses: English 12 AS, US History Adv, AS Biology, AS Chemistry, Calculus I & II, College Algebra, Sociology, Spanish 4, French 4, Principles of Business, Adv Visual Arts, First Year Experience, & Sports Education. Through an agreement with Genesee Community College's Accelerated College College Enrollment (ACE) students can

obtain college credit for being enrolled in these courses. Information is available at www.genesee.edu/acc

A unit of credit is awarded for a full year course when the final grade is 65 or higher. Final grade is computed using a ratio of 4/5 for class work and 1/5 for final examination. A one-semester course earns ½ credit if passed with a grade of 65 or higher.
