SUBJECT: Naming of an Endowed Scholarship Fund at the State University of New York at Buffalo

Action Requested

The proposed resolution names the Broadview Federal Credit Union Scholarship at the State University of New York at Buffalo.

Resolution

I recommend that the Board of Trustees adopt the following resolution:

Whereas, Broadview Federal Credit Union has a commitment to the communities it serves, investing in food insecurity and hunger programs, health and well-being, addressing homelessness and affordable housing, safe communities and individual well-being in New York State; and

Whereas, general scholarship dollars are vital to UB in order to provide flexible, immediate support that helps students access and complete a world-class education regardless of financial background; and

Whereas, UB is committed to recruiting talented students, reducing loan burdens, closing unexpected financial gaps that might otherwise interrupt a student's progress, and empowering students to focus on academic achievement, research, and

campus engagement rather than financial stress; now, therefore, be it

Resolved that, in recognition of the philanthropic commitment by Broadview Federal Credit Union, the Broadview Federal Credit Union Scholarship at the State University of New York at Buffalo is hereby named.

Background

Broadview Federal Credit Union formed in August 2022 through the merger of SEFCU (State Employees Federal Credit Union) and CAP COM Federal Credit Union and currently represents one of the largest credit unions in the Northeast. With over \$8 billion in assets and serving nearly 500,000 members, Broadview is a mission-driven financial institution that offers a wide range of financial services, including personal and business banking, loans, and more.
