Apply to SUNY

- 4 29 of the 30 SUNY Community Colleges offer individual applications (often at no cost)



Discuss Students' Best Test-Optional Answer

SUNY has temporarily suspended SAT/ACT testing requirements for students applying for admission to SUNY bachelor's degree-granting colleges. Students may decide whether or not to include scores for admission consideration at each college to which they apply.

If students believe their scores are an accurate representation of their ability, SUNY colleges can consider them along with all other materials in the application file. If they think their scores do not represent their abilities, SUNY colleges can holistically evaluate the application without considering them.

You may find the middle 50% information on the SUNY Admissions Information Summaries helpful.



Discuss Students' Best Test-Optional Answer

In some instances, however, test scores may still be required. Admission to select programs, consideration for some merit scholarships, and NCAA eligibility for Division I student-athletes may require test scores. International students, who are non-native English speakers, and whose primary language of instruction in high school was not English, are required to demonstrate English proficiency by submitting scores from SAT, ACT, TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE.

Students will have an opportunity to check “Yes” or “No” when they apply for admission. Although they cannot change their preference online, once the application has been submitted, they may contact the Office of Admissions at the colleges to which they have applied to request adjustments.



There's More Than One Path to a Bachelor's Degree

- 1 More than 45% of SUNY baccalaureate graduates begin as transfer students.
- 2 SUNY's Transfer Paths summarize the common lower division requirements shared by all SUNY campuses for similar majors within most disciplines.
- 3 Additionally, several SUNY Community Colleges and Four-Year Colleges have direct transfer Pathway Programs.



FREE Application Weeks!

- 1 SUNY Free Application Weeks will run Monday, October 21 through Sunday, November 3.
- 2 During this time, students can apply to up to five SUNY campuses without paying application fees. This applies to all campuses, whether students use the Common app or the SUNY app.

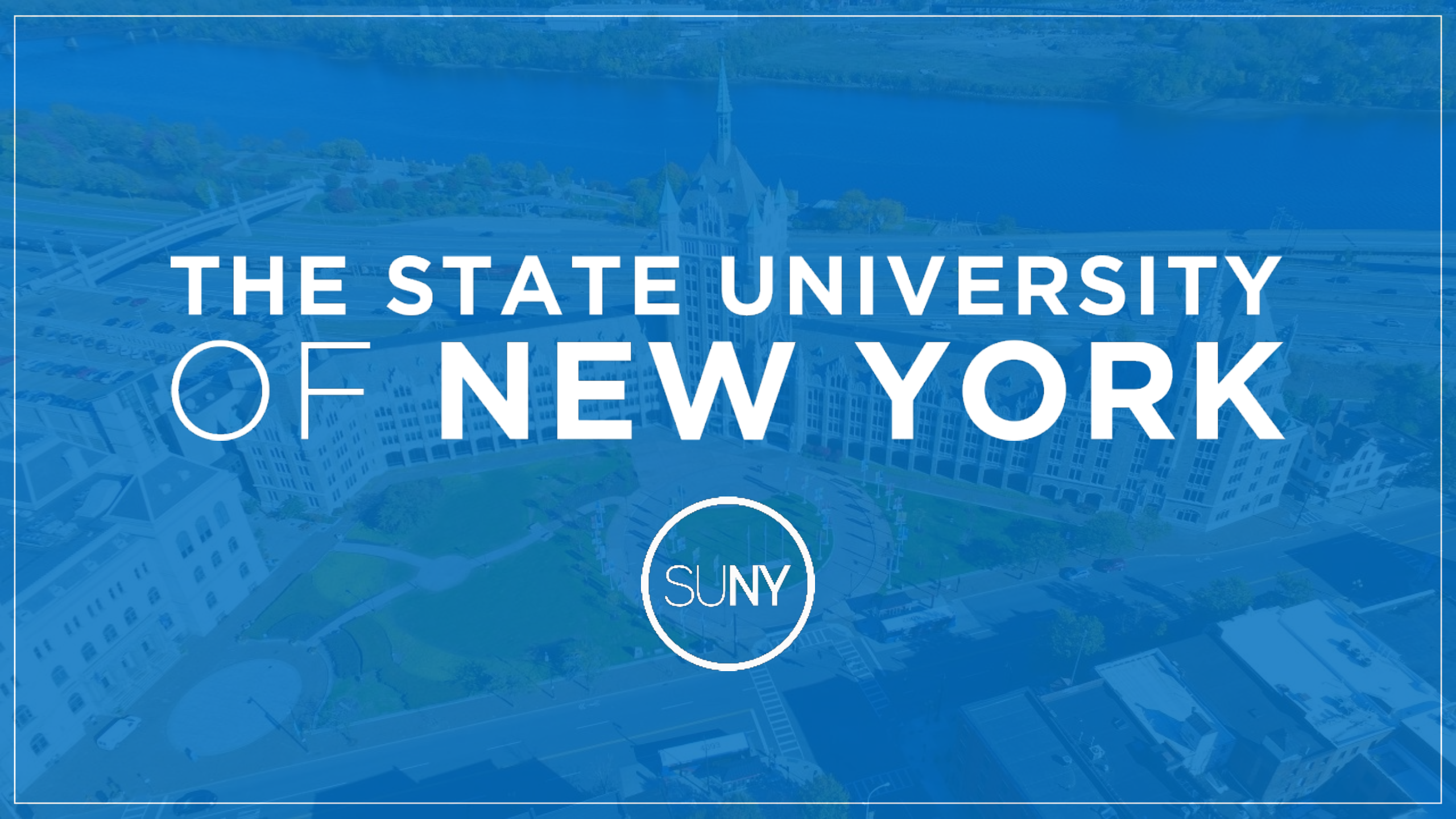
