



## SUNY Leadership Institute Programs Campus Statement of Commitment

The SUNY Leadership Institutes are rigorous, in-depth programs which require significant commitment and time investment. Fellows are required to attend scheduled meetings, sessions, webinars, and leadership retreats, and complete assigned tasks. Participation in the Leadership Programs will also require time away from the Fellow's workplace. For these programs to be impactful, each Fellow accepted into their respective programs must be fully supported by their campus leadership, including their direct supervisor.

The 10-month curriculum begins in January and ends in October, and includes, but is not limited to:

- January: Kickoff with a two-day in-person orientation retreat (Albany)
- February/March: Optional conference participation (pending available funding)
- April: Two-day in-person leadership retreat (Albany)
- June: Two-day in-person summer retreat (Albany)
- September: Two-day in-person retreat (Albany)
- October: One-day in-person capstone event (Albany)
- Monthly: Group webinars with guest speakers (Virtual)
- Ongoing: Additional webinars and conference calls with leadership experts as scheduled

The programs cover the costs associated with meetings, materials, speakers, and related expenses. Lodging, breakfast, and lunch are also provided during in-person meetings, when appropriate. However, participants are responsible for their own transportation and evening meals, which may require financial support from their home institution.
