



## NYS Master Teacher Program, Counselor cohort 2025-2026 Praxis Exam Guide

The NYS Master Teacher Program application requires one of the Praxis® Subject Assessments (formerly the Praxis II® Content Exams) that is listed on the Praxis Exam Guide below. We recommend that the applicant register for the exam that will best demonstrate their mastery.

Please review all pages in this Praxis Exam Guide before registering for an exam. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that the Praxis® Subject Assessments they take meets application requirements outlined in the tables below. ### The Exam

Exam codes that begin with a 5 are computer-delivered. All tests are delivered by computer. There is also an option for at home testing on a home computer or other secure location. All exams must be taken by the application deadline. To register, visit [www.ets.org/praxis](http://www.ets.org/praxis).

We advise all applicants to review “The Praxis® Tests Information Bulletin” for general information about the exams, registration and taking the exam.

If the applicant has previously taken an exam accepted for application to the NYS Master Counselor application, they may provide the original score report or request an official report to be sent to the NYS Master Teacher Program using the state/agency code **7780**.

### Registration Options and Accommodations

Please review the complete set of accommodations available on the ETS.org/Praxis website. Testing on a Monday can be arranged for those applicants whose religious convictions or active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces prevent them from testing on Saturday. Extended testing time is also available for test takers whose primary language is not English (PLNE). Additional accommodations are detailed for test takers with disabilities or health-related needs.

### Picking a Date

Applicants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the test dates for the Praxis® Subject Assessments (formerly the Praxis II® Content Knowledge tests) they intend to take. All applicants must take the Praxis® Subject Assessments (formerly the Praxis II® Content Knowledge tests) before or by the application deadline.

We strongly encourage all applicants to schedule their exam well in advance of the application deadline should there be a need to reschedule. The deadline to take a Praxis II exam accepted for application is the deadline to submit an application.

- An applicant may take their Praxis exam prior to submitting their application. Follow the instructions above to ensure that their score is reported to the NYS Master Teacher Program, code 7780.
- All applicants are required to provide their test registration information (test and date) in their application.
- The applicant is required to take one exam from the list of accepted exams in the *NYS Master Teacher Program Praxis Guide for K-12 Counselors* by the application deadline.
- The applicant does not need to have received the exam score before submitting the online application, however the application will not be complete if the applicant has not taken the exam by the required deadline.

### Fees

The fee for taking the Praxis Exam is \$130, paid directly to the Educational Testing Service. To ensure that their score report is sent to the NYS Master Teacher Program, enter state/agency code **7780** when registering for the tests.

### Hardship

If paying the exam fee causes a financial hardship for the applicant or their family, they may apply for reimbursement. Please review the document “PRAXIS Reimbursement Request Form” on the NYS Master Teacher Program website. Applicants are asked to send a copy of the signed form with a letter of no more than one page that includes family income, family size, and an explanation of the nature of the hardship to [masterteacherprogram@suny.edu](mailto:masterteacherprogram@suny.edu). PRAXIS reimbursement requests are due by the application deadline. The applicant does not have to be accepted into the program to be eligible for reimbursement.

\*The PRAXIS Reimbursement Request Form is only available for download during an application cycle.

### Scores

An applicant’s Praxis Subject Test exam score is one of many components considered in their Master Teacher application. Throughout the online application, applicants are encouraged to share specific examples of mastery of and goals for growth for each of the three domains, knowledge of career development, knowledge of academic development, and knowledge of social and emotional development. A score between 150 and 160 is considered a passing score.

*No applicant is guaranteed an interview and selection for a high score and no applicant is removed from consideration for a low score.*

If an applicant has taken an exam on the list of accepted exams for application prior to the 2024-2025 application cycle, they have two options for reporting their score to the NYSMTP:

1. Upload a PDF of the official score report from ETS to their application,  
**OR**
2. Contact ETS and request that a score report be sent to the NYSMTP state agency code 7780.
