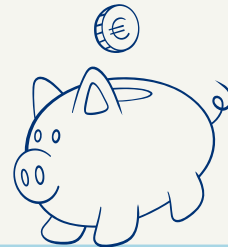




# SOURCES OF AID





01

## Federal

Requires the FAFSA application  
Almost exclusively need-based  
May include grants, work-study, or loans  
Can be used at all colleges in the country

## State

Generally requires both FAFSA and NYS applications  
Used by residents attending in-state colleges and universities  
Primarily need-based grants and criteria-based scholarships  
Includes Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) and Excelsior Scholarship

## Campus

May require separate application  
Can be used only at that campus  
Criteria varies, may be based on academics, talents, or need  
Institutional aid does not require repayment

## Private

Will require their own application, may also require FAFSA  
Opportunities for scholarships, grants, and loans  
Criteria, requirements, amounts, and applications vary  
Most can be used at all colleges across the country
