Applications will be accepted between November 1st, 2014 and February 15th, 2015. Email the following materials as a single PDF attachment to nysafahfellow@suny.edu. Email should have the subject line “NYSFAFH-SUNY Fellowship 2015”:

1. A completed NYSFAFH_SUNY 2015 Fellowship application.
2. A personal statement, detailing the applicant’s interest in affordable housing. This must be no more than one page, single space, size 12 font, 1” margins.
3. An up-to-date, professional resume.
4. Two letters of recommendation. At least one should be from a professor at the applicant’s current institution.
5. An electronic, unofficial transcript from your current institution is also required. This can be uploaded as a separate file the same email.
