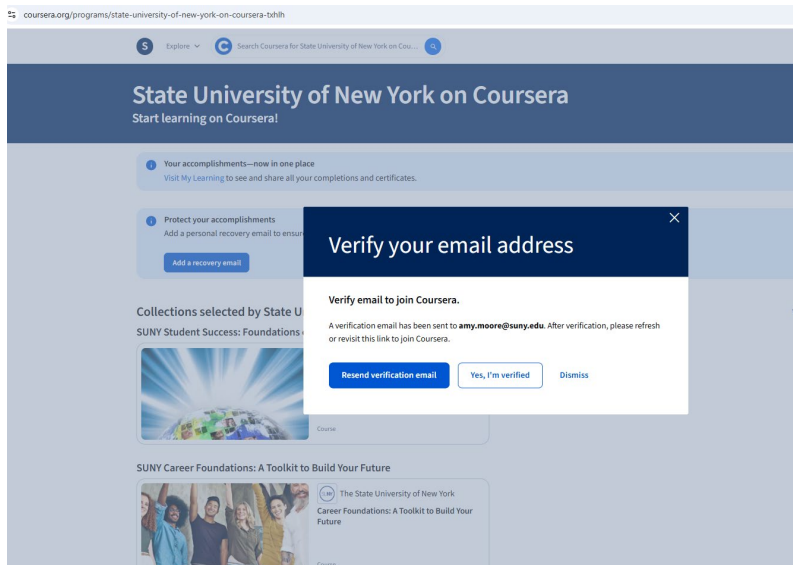




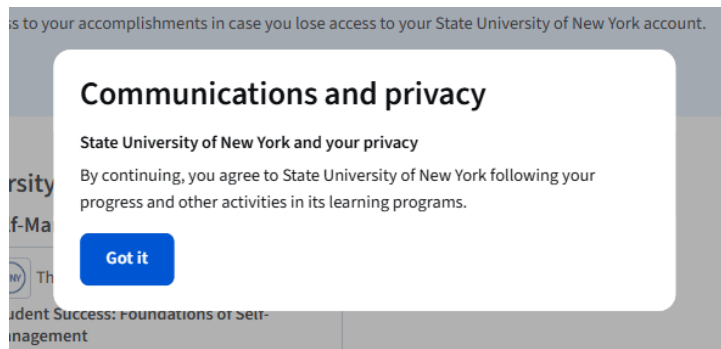
Instructions to Activate Free SUNY SimAcademy Access

SUNY faculty, staff, and students with a SUNY campus email address are eligible for free access to SUNY SimAcademy through Coursera. Follow the steps below to create a free Coursera account and access the program:

1. Navigate to Coursera at www.coursera.org
2. Create a free account using your SUNY-affiliated .edu email address
3. While logged in, navigate to <https://coursera.org/programs/state-university-of-new-york-on-coursera-txhlh>
 - A. The first time you access this page, you will be asked to verify your e-mail address (screenshot below)

- C. After verifying, agree to SUNY privacy policy by clicking "Got it"
