What's the Difference?

ASAP (Advancing Success in Associate Pathways) support for associate degrees
ACE (Advancing Completion through Engagement) support for bachelor's degrees

Who is Eligible?*

Must receive at least \$1 of Pell, TAP, or Excelsior Scholarship, be a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen, be eligible for in-state tuition, and enroll full-time in a degree program supported by the campus.

Prior college experience

- ASAP: First-time student or those with no more than 21 applicable college credits earned after high school and at least a 2.0 GPA
- ACE: First-time students or transfer students with an associate degree

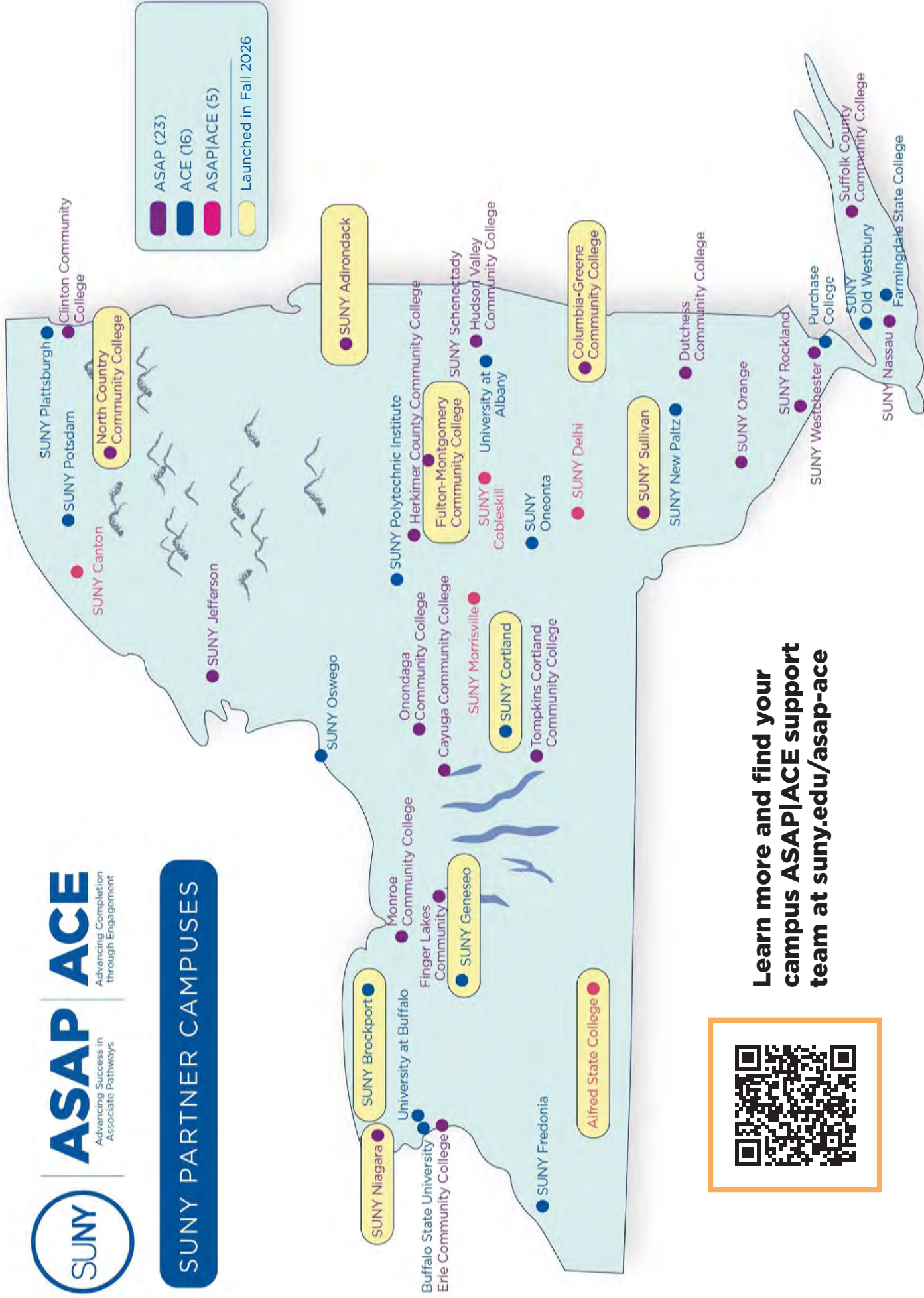
