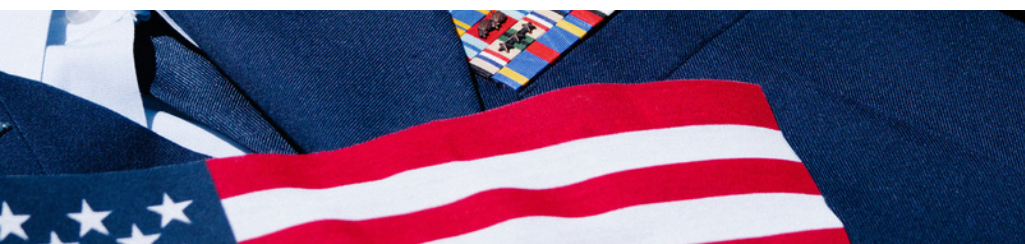
- Non-profit public university system offering high-quality programs at low cost
