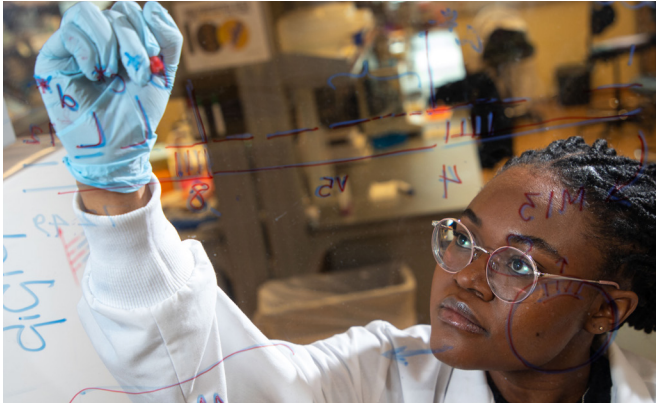

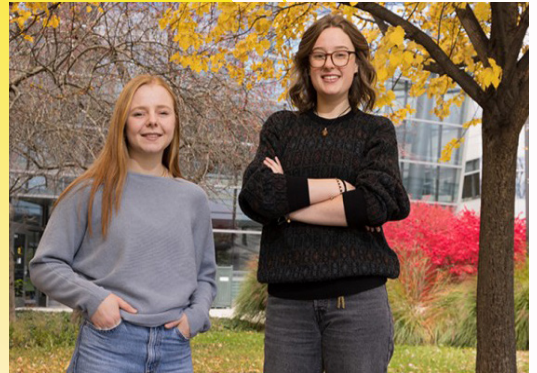


NAI **PENNSYLVANIA**

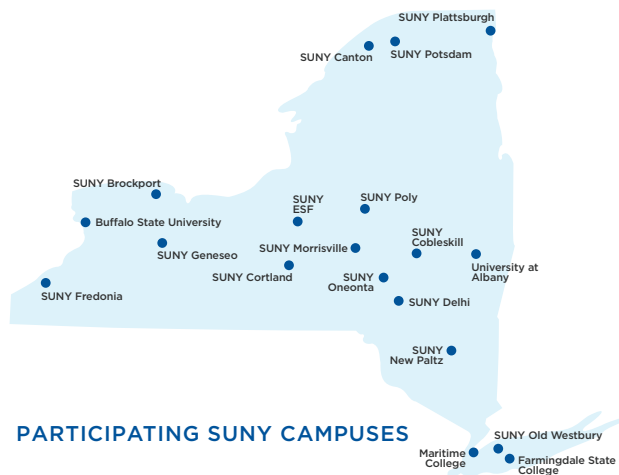


TUITION MATCH
