Applying to Honors Programs

Applying to the Educational Opportunity Program (EOP)

The Educational Opportunity Program makes it possible for students who have limited financial resources and who are academically underprepared to pursue higher education at SUNY.

Before applying, review eligibility guidelines at suny.edu/attend/academics/eop/. Then, complete your application for admission and indicate your interest in EOP. Most campuses require supplemental information, as well as financial documentation to determine your eligibility.
