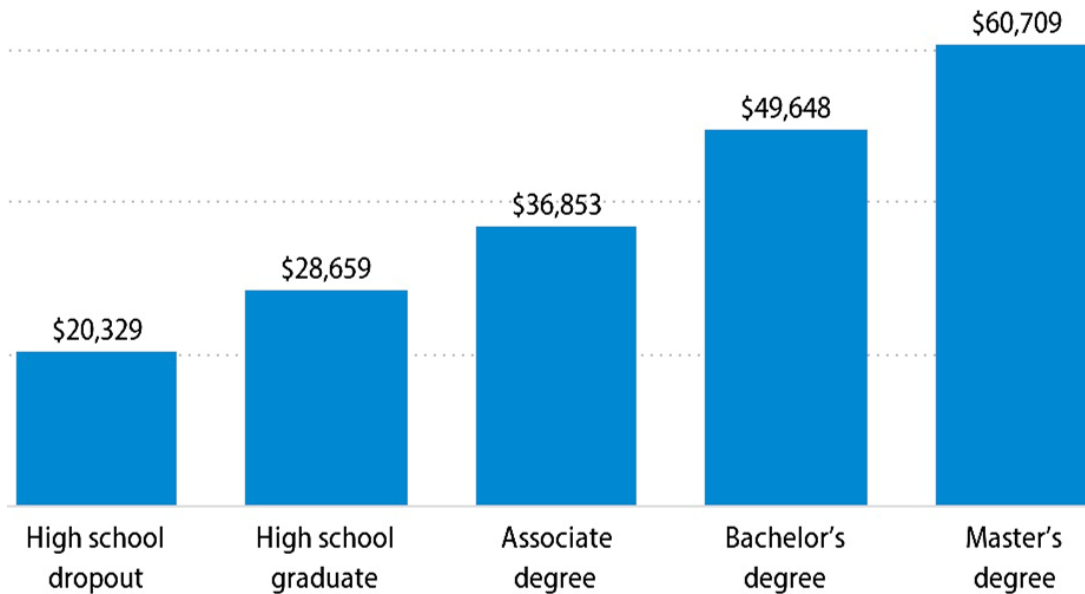

Add one year of college to the region's workforce, and GDP per capita jumps 17.4%

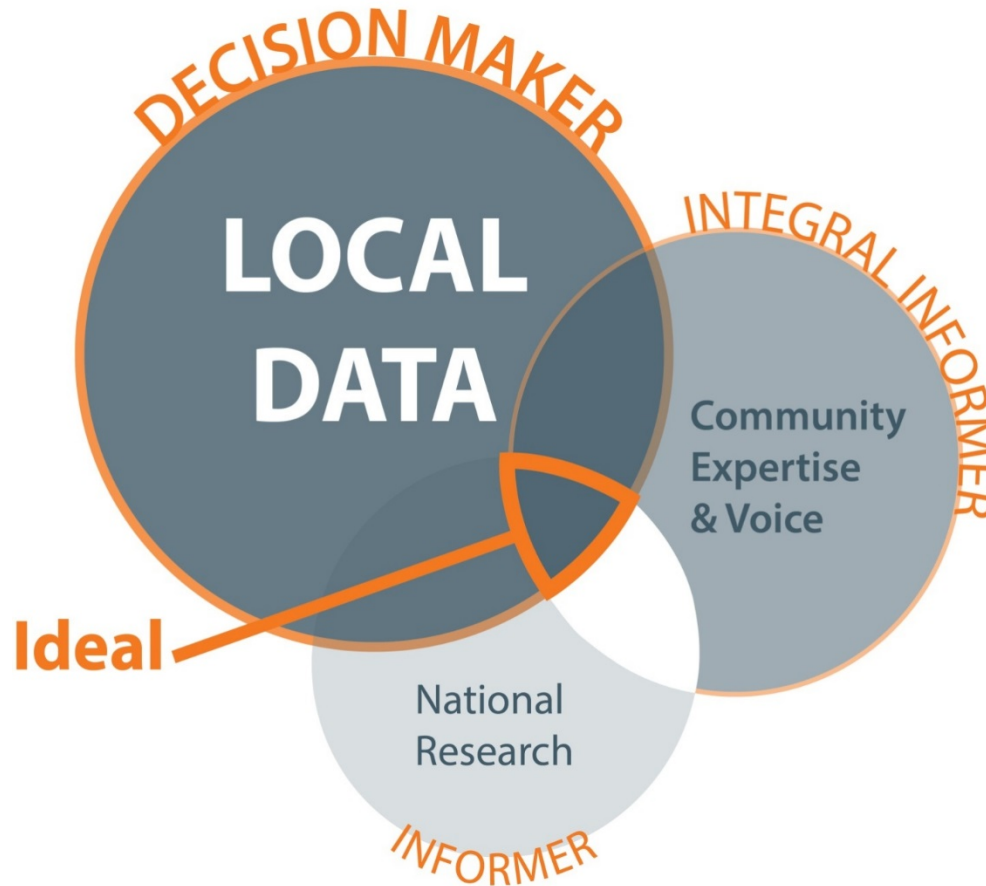

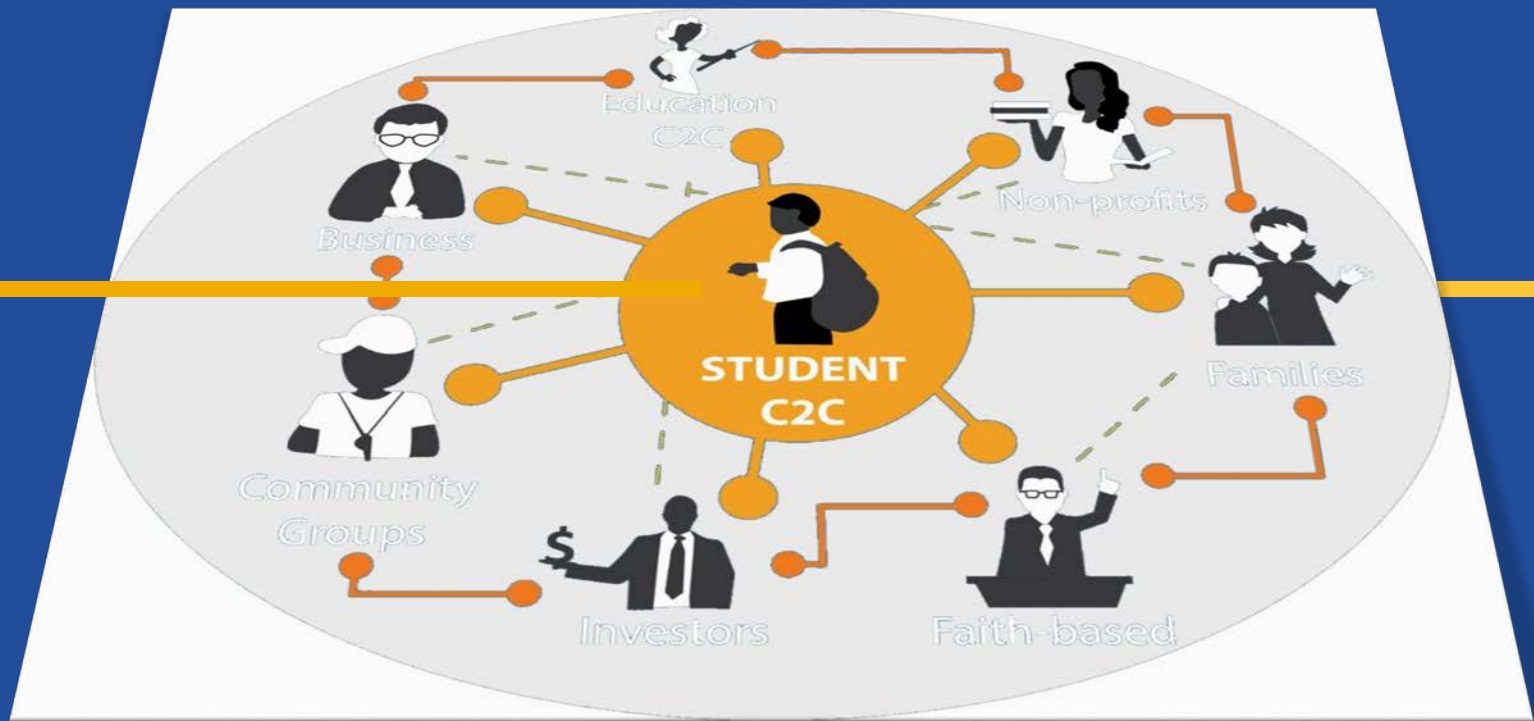

ready to enter Kindergarten

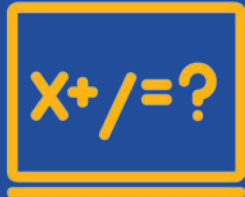


EARLY GRADE READING

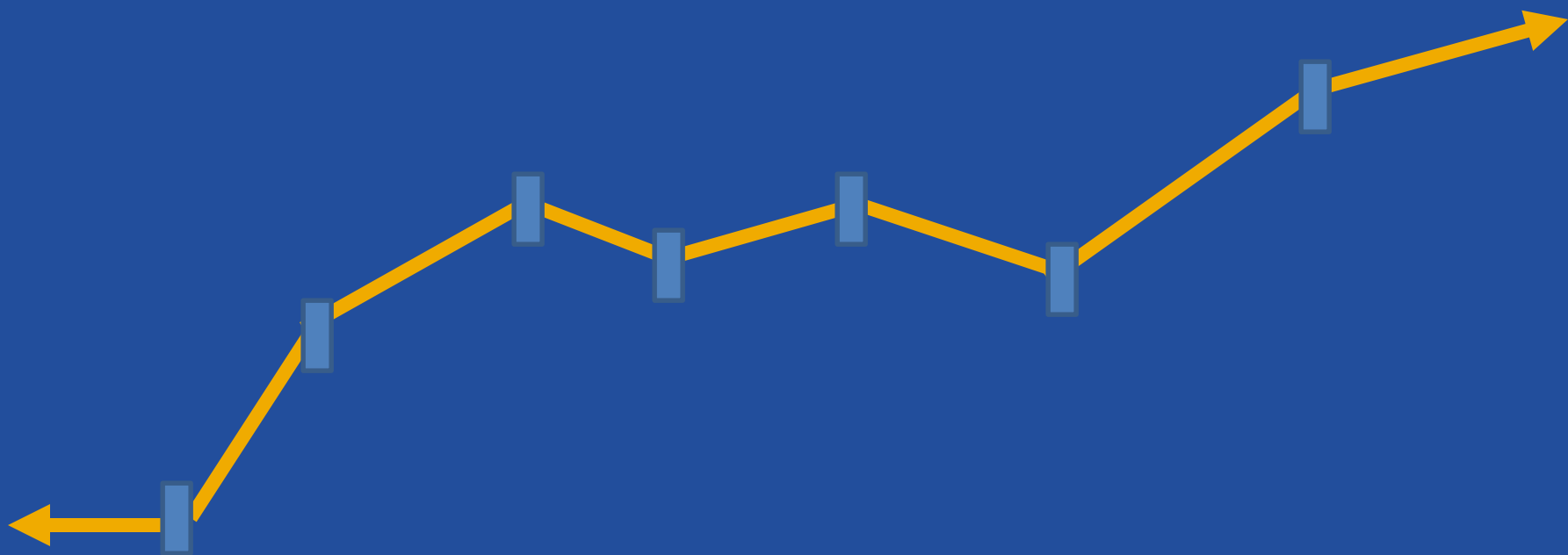
